Terminology

Set: One go behind the boat. This lasts 10 minutes.

Tow: Another word for set.

Operator: This is somebody who has been officially signed up by the Chairman to be responsible in the running of the club. They will be first point of contact in any event, handle all cash and will be a qualified Ski-boat driver. There may be more than one present.

Jetty Marshall: This is someone appointed by the Operator to make sure the Club runs smoothly. On occasion, the Club has been extremely busy and good organisation is required to ensure as many people as possible get to have a go.

Section Day: This is a day in the week that anyone may organise for their work section to have the boat to themselves for the day. If you would like to organise one of these days then please contact your Station I/C.

So how do I get involved?

The Club is open on most weekends during the summer season. This runs roughly from April to October. The Club is also open during some weekday evenings, depending on Operator availability.

On the Club website, there is a Diary on the front page which denotes who is working the Club and when. When you see the club is open you may simply turn up and have a go.

Alternatively, you can call the Club's mobile to see if there is anyone there and if so, head on down.

Or, you could call me (your friendly Station I/C) and I will find out for you when the club will next be open.

Although it may seem intimidating to arrive at a Club where everyone knows each other and the protocol, please know that we are a friendly bunch of people that are only interested in hanging out, having fun and learning the sport.

Price List

The cost of membership is £120. Price per set is £6

Breakdown:

RAF Station membership (dependant on you unit) £40

Tattershall Lakes Membership £40

British Wakeboard and Water-ski membership £40

If you are new to the sport then you are welcome to visit and have a go before you pay membership. However, Tattershall Lakes' policy is, you must pay £15 for a day's membership before you are allowed on the water (if you visit just to watch then you don't have to pay anything). It is then £6 a go.

On your third visit to Tattershall Lakes, you must become a full member. The £30 paid for the previous two visits is deducted from your £120 membership price (you must keep your receipt stubs to claim this money).

All money is paid to the Operator. For full membership payment, it must be in the form of three Cheques along with the relevant paperwork. I have included the paperwork at the back of this pack-up. If you have any problems filling it, take it to the lake with you and the Operator will help you through it.

Membership is effective immediately after payment.

How to get there:

On arrival of the lake, you may find the barrier is down. If this is the case, you will need to park up and sign in. This is done in the small office on the right hand side.

Then follow the road all the way until you reach a T-junction and turn left. Take the right at the roundabout which takes you past the club house. Follow the road until you reach another roundabout (by the Jet Ski Lake) and take the right

exit. Our caravan is slightly further up on the right hand side. You will recognise it by the number eight on the side.

Please note, there is only space on the site for two cars and one of those spaces is reserved for the operator. If both spaces are taken, the best place to park is in front of the building by the Jet Ski Lake and then walk back to the caravan. Please don't cram your car behind the two that are there as there is not enough space and it becomes a hazard to other road users.

Additional Information

The following list shows the items I would recommend bringing for a weekend at the lakes. It is based on turning up on a Saturday morning and leaving on a Sunday afternoon.

- Swim shorts
- Sun Cream
- Wash bag
- Food
- Drink
- Sleeping bag
- Warm outer clothing
- Sunglasses
- Cheque Book (for membership)
- Cash (for Sets, correct change if possible)

As far as food goes, there are full cooking facilities in the Caravan. We have a cooker, a hob and a microwave and you may take full use of all Club cutlery, plates and glasses.

After your set, you can have a hot shower to warm up if necessary.

If you are a serving member of the RAF, we would also encourage you to join the RAF Sports Lottery. Not only do the RAF Sports board help us with funding immensely, but you get a discounted entry (£10 for every ticket) into the Annual RAF Championships and a weekly chance to pocket £6000! The Sports Lottery was created in 1993 to provide additional funds to meet requests for help in financing sporting activity and endeavour in the RAF. There are currently over 27,000 members holding in excess of 65,000 tickets. This generates an annual income of £2.5 million. After running costs and prize money around £1 million is available to sports associations, stations and individual sportsmen and women.

The lottery is a series of separate and distinct weekly draws. Each ticket costs 75p per week and each member can hold a maximum of 5 tickets. Currently, a total of £20,000 is paid out each week in 12 separate cash prizes.

- 6th - 8th £1,000
